Occupation-specific Language Training

Occupation-specific Language Training (OSLT) is offered at no cost for newcomers to Ontario. Participants must be permanent residents or protected persons and have:

- training or experience in a specific occupation or sector, but need to improve their occupation-specific communication skills.
- language proficiency at Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) levels 6 to 8 in at least one language skill area or Niveaux de compétence linguistique canadiens (NCLC) of 6 to 8 for courses taught in French.

Participants will develop the language and communication skills needed to:

- understand workplace culture in their occupation and sector.
- interact effectively with their colleagues, clients and supervisors.
- give and receive information by email and telephone.
- interview and network effectively.
