## What is it?

This one-page document lists community services that can be accessed in French in Scarborough. Some are Francophone agencies, other have a French-speaking staff position. One side is English, and the Other in French. It can be reference by service providers as well as community members seeking services.

Some agencies are based in Scarborough, others are based downtown and offer itinerant services in Scarborough, and some do not have fixed locations (i.e. sexual health info line). The document can be kept as a reference by front-line workers, at the reception of organizations, and bulleting boards. ## Why is this important?

Though French isn't among the very top languages spoken by newcomers in Scarborough, there has been an increase in newcomers coming from Francophone countries settling in Scarborough, and agencies have been offering more and more support services in French. Because the number of Francophones is relatively small, awareness of available services is low, and many will not be aware of their options when it comes to accessing settlement, employment, and health support in French.

French is an official language in 29 countries and is spoken is even more countries that that. Many newcomers come from countries where French is a common second language, or the language of education. Being aware of who may speak French, and of the services that are available, helps us to provide more options to community members in accessing services in a language that they understand well.
